1. To work for the well-being and care of the brave and proud people.
2. To take care and preservation of cattle, lands, trees, water resources, monuments and environment through a variety of steps relevant to a particular situation obtaining at any time.
3. To give medical, surgical and maternity relief to all people irrespective of caste, creed and community and for that purpose to establish, conduct, and maintain dispensaries, hospitals, maternity homes, health centres, etc.
4. To help, establish and manage dispensaries, hospitals, maternity homes, nursing homes, nature cure centres, ayurvedic, unani, homeopathic centres, diagnostic centres and institutions of like nature dedicated to the health care, well-being and welfare of people.
5. To help for improvement of quality of life in the village in every possible manner including nutrition, sanitation, education, family planning, health care, cottage industries, energy management, drinking water, animal husbandry, conservation, entertainment and similar other measures and schemes to uplift the material, social and spiritual standards of people living in villages and in this process, to avail of, and promote the use of appropriate, even though modern and sophisticated technologies.
6. To conduct, the above mentioned institutions either alone or in co-operation with other institutions;
7. To impart and promote education in arts, science, technical, vocational courses in industry, commerce, agriculture, etc. and in any other subject or subjects which the trustees may decide;
8. To start, conduct and maintain schools, colleges, laboratories, research centres, libraries, reading rooms either alone or in co-operation with other institutions;
9. To give scholarships, funds and/or other charitable help to the deserving students, and to supply books, free of cost to such students;
10. Promotion of self control, social, social intercourse, human relations, culture and ethical or moral standards.
11. Help to the poor, needy and infirm.
12. Promotion of moral, intellectual, social and physical improvements.
13. Preservation of places of historic interest or natural beauty.
14. Promotion and improvement of agriculture, agriculture science and protection of animals useful to man.
15. Promotion of industrial knowledge, commercial knowledge and arts.
16. Creation, maintenance supply of or support to gardens, gymnasium, physical culture and other means of public recreation for advancement of health and hygiene.

17. Relief of distress of man, animals, birds and all living beings.
18. Help in times of epidemics, famines, floods, earth-quakes and unforeseen occurrences.
19. To provide knowledge, training, education, exposure for rural and urban population for effective management of renewable resources of land, water, air energy and space.
20. To provide help and assistance in procuring agriculture. Horticulture, animal husbandry inputs in the form of seeds tissue culture plants, saplings, fertilizers soil enriched agrochemicals, preservation chemicals, equipment and tools and any other farm inputs.
21. To provide assistance in marketing agro outputs.
