As long as the sight is
Centered between the brows
There is no fear.

Concentration is con-centration the conscious centering of the sight.

With Con-centration the object becomes the central point and the focus is fixed without any wavering.

There are two views. The right view and the left view. When you look only with right eye there is only a partial sight. Where right side predominates. When you look only with left eye there is only partial sight. Where left side dominates.

When right eye and left eye center there is a common view. Full view and middle view. Where both side merge and you can see all side whole and no-side point.

Pointed view brings all the mid-energy into one focus and there is a total attention. Total attention with full intention migrates all the tension and there is No-tension situation.

When the two sights are centered between the brows your sight is middle and you are at equilibrium. Then all the objects on this line from the point on the fore head to any point forward are aligned. Then having centered the sight line, you can focus to any distance from zero to infinity from yourself to all the way.

When the two sights are not merged and not centered there is a fear of partial view, incomplete picture and there is a change and possibility of missing some thing important.

As there are two 'EYE's with two sights there are two 'I's with two views.

The TWO 'I's are two half's of the mind. The intuitional 'I', the right half of the brain and the intellectual or logical 'I', the left half of the brain.

The right 'I' is artistic and creative dealing with pictures, figures, music and art. It thinks and feels in concepts and notice the feelings.

The left 'I' is logical and calculative dealing with numbers, letters, system and logical steps. It thinks and connects the details and notices thoughts and judgments.

Every person is an integration of feminine and masculine nature. Every person is “Ardha Narishwar” the lord of half man + half woman.

The left 'I' and right 'I' together make the integration of two personalities.

When left and right are merging the holistic personality emerges. Left view is logical, authoritative, systematic, calculative, judgmental, step-by-step, sequential and cold view.

Right view is creative, responsive, free, imaginative, intuition frame-by-frame, parallel and warm view.

The center view is the merger of both views where logic and creativity, authority and responsibility, system and freedom, calculations and imagination, judgment and intuition, step-by-step and frame-by-frame, sequential and parallel and cold and warm merge with each other. When such merger of right and left and intuition and intellect occurs the consciousness arises.

Concentration leads to conscious center.

You be conscious center where you are beyond right and left. Heat and cold, like and dislike, charging and hatred, yes and no and less and more. Avoiding taking any side, either seeking nor avoiding be a person of No-side and all sides.

Not sticking to or avoiding any one be a person for all the people.

Relate to every body without becoming relative of any body. See both sides of all issues and find the optimal path. For every problems, without exception, there is an optimal solution. Optimal solution is that situation where moving to any side will reduce the overall effectiveness.

Center your Eyes and our 'I's and become highest of high.

That's why when you transient the quality. You will merge your two's into one. Then you are original 'ONE' which appears as two in this creation.
